

Accidents happen, and when they do, spot cleaning is an effective way to address minor stains on your silk duvet insert. Use a mild detergent mixed with cold water to gently dab the stained area. Avoid rubbing, as this can damage the delicate silk fibers. Once the stain is lifted, blot the area with a clean, damp cloth to remove any soap residue, then allow it to air dry completely before using the duvet again.

Washing Instructions

When your silk duvet insert needs a thorough cleaning, it's important to follow specific washing instructions to prevent damage. Most silk duvet inserts are labeled as dry clean only, but if you prefer to wash at home, use a gentle cycle with cold water and a detergent specifically designed for silk. Do not wring or twist the fabric, as this can cause permanent damage.



Long-Term Care
